Admission Eligibility TK

A child must turn five years of age between September 1 - December 31 to be eligible for Transitional Kindergarten (TK). It is advisable that children have pre-school experience before attending TK.

Admission Eligibility Kinder - 8th (These Guidelines are set by our Department of Catholic Schools)

A child must be five years of age by September 1 to be eligible for entrance into Kindergarten. It is advisable that children have pre-school experience before attending Kindergarten.

Application Process

Application due dates: **TK/Kindergarten: December 12, 2025**

Grades 1 - 8: February 6, 2026

Application includes:

- Completed online application forms
 - Child's birth certificate
 - Baptism certificate (if applicable)
 - Recent report card(s): previous 2 years for Grades 2-8; previous year for Grade 1; preschool record form for TK/K (if applicable)
 - \$100 non-refundable application fee
- You will be contacted to schedule your child's screening date (applicable to TK/K only) when your application is completed and returned. Please bring your child to his/her screening at the assigned time.
 - You will be notified of acceptance within 2 weeks of your child's assessment (TK/K applicants) and within a week of your child's assessment (Grades 1 - 8 applicants).
 - There is a \$550 non-refundable Registration Fee due within 2 weeks of acceptance to hold a spot.
